Half Of Texas Crops On Irrigated Cropland

More than 50 percent of the total dollar value of harvested crops in Texas in 1979 was from irrigated cropland, which represented about a third of the total cropland in the State, according to a report released by the Texas Department of Water Resources.

"Inventories of Irrigation in Texas, 1968, 1969, 1969, 1974, and 1979" shows that the leading irrigated crops in 1979 were cotton with 2,260,300 acres, grain sorghum with 1,265,400 acres, wheat with 1,225,500 acres, and corn with 984,200 acres. Copies of the report, No. 263, may be obtained without charge from the TDWR Publications Distribution Unit, P. O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711.

The report is based on inventories made cooperatively by the Texas Department of Water Resources, the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and the Texas State Soil and Water Conservation Board. Most of the basic data previously published in 1968, 1964, 1969, and 1974 inventories are included in the new 1979 inventory report. Due to relatively high rainfall during the 1979 growing season in many parts of Texas, less acreage was irrigated and less water was applied in 1979 than in the prior inventory in 1974.

Fall Planting Important To Onion Growers

Late fall is an important time for connoisseurs of garden-grown onions. Soils will cool to an optimum seed germination temperature and the optimum monthly average temperatures for good growth will occur soon after emergence of the onion seedlings.

Late October and early November is the time to plant seed of the "Bermuda" onion types as well as the famous sweet Texas onion, Grano 502 in the area of Texas. When you label an onion as a "Bermuda," you really haven't said much. The general term "Bermuda" usually refers to the white or red onion used on hamburgers. Actually, the white "Bermuda" onion is the Crystal Wax variety and the red "Bermuda" onion is the Burgundy Red variety. The term "Bermuda" is a nameless variety inherited by onions which at one time were propagated on the Bermuda Islands. This procedure was followed only to enhance seed production and did not signify any specific quality factors.

Seeds can be sown directly into the garden in Colorado County, covered with one-fourth inch of soil and should sprout within 7 to 10 days. If planted thickly plants can be pulled and utilized as green onions or scallions for eating in 8 to 10 weeks. However, most gardeners want to grow an onion bulb as large as a basketball. To do this, the onion plants must be thinned in early spring until they are two to three inches apart to insure adequate bulb expansion. These thinned plants can be eaten or transplanted into another area of the garden so that these, too, will have adequate space in which to grow into large bulbs.

Fertilization of onion plants is also vital to success. Research findings indicate that onion growth and yield can be greatly enhanced by banding phosphorus two to three inches below seed at planting time.

RR Commission Asks Comments On SF Closings

Deadline For Protests Is Closing E.L. Office Is December 1st

The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company has filed an application with the Texas Railroad Commission to close the agency stations in Eagle Lake, Newburg and Wharton and to create a regional freight agency at Bay City, Texas.

The Commission advises that persons or businesses wishing to protest such action have until December 1st (Tuesday) to have such protests in the hands of the commission in Austin. At the time of application, Santa Fe announced plans to maintain a regional yard office in Eagle Lake, the office to be staffed with personnel to support and to assist the regional freight office in train operations and customer services.

In filing the application, D. E. Massey, assistant general manager for the company, Amarillo, noted that there is a limited staff on duty eight hours per day at the stations at the present time. "They are often unable to provide quick responses to requests about rates, car supply or car location. By having direct access to our computer, the new regional freight office will be able to respond to such questions much more quickly." He added that the Bay City office will be open an expanded number of hours each day and will give customers access to a toll-free number.

Protests must be filed in order to be in the commission office not later than Dec. 1st by mailing to Capitol Station, Austin, Texas 78711. For more information, you can contact Vickie Barnett at (512) 445-1344.
