Box 102, Garwood, Texas 77442 applicants, seek a permit pursuant to §11.121, Texas Water Code, and Rules 156.02.05.001 et seq. to maintain an existing dam and 20 acre-foot capacity reservoir on West Mustang Creek, tributary of Mustang Creek, tributary of the Navada River, tributary of the Lavaca River, in the Lavaca River Basin. Applicants also seek authority to divert from the reservoir 140 acre-feet of state water per year for the purpose of irrigating 70 acres of land in Colorado County. Diversion would be at a maximum rate of 2.22 cfs (1000 gpm) from a point on the reservoir which is N44° W, 2600 feet from the east corner of the E.B.B. & C. RR Co. Survey, Abstract No. 125, in Colorado County, approximately 20 miles southeast of Columbus, all being more fully set out in the application.
