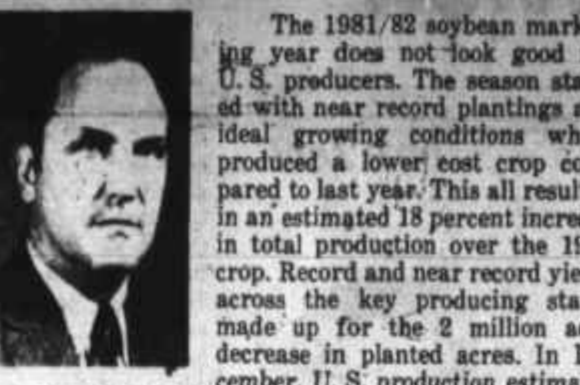
Joe Mahalic To Be Alternate Judge At Houston Show
