

Showers and thunderstorms over the Texas Coastal Constructors Plains Tuesday should have been swept out with the passage of a cold front late Tuesday afternoon and early evening. Several days of cold but dry weather are expected to follow. A change to windy and colder weather will place considerable cold stress on livestock. Managers should be planning to increase herd feeding and continue extra offerings of hay and supplements both Wednesday and Thursday. Wind chill factor Tuesday night on exposed animals could run in the 10 to 15 degree range, so it could **Commercial & Residential Construction** be very important to move healthy herds into pastures providing north wind protection. Special care and **Blueprint & House Planning Service** sheltering of new calves and cows ready to deliver may help avoid weather related stock losses. 
