Clayments agreed to release \$500,000 from his emergency funds for pesticide purchases. He also offered to allocate additional emergency funds in case of severe pest outbreaks this summer, this action allowing Brown to utilize \$500,000 appropriated to his department for pest control contingencies.

"We appreciate the Governor's response to our request," Brown said. By the second delivery period in May, 33 of the 88 counties requesting participation will receive all of the pesticide ordered.

"The U.S. Department of Agriculture notified us in March that its share in the Texas program would be \$900,000. But as other Southern states entered the program, that amount was reduced to \$814,000," Brown said.

"When the U.S. Department of Agriculture funds are released and as payments from counties are added, more pesticide will be purchased. We will prorate as much as possible to the infested counties as soon as we have the material."

If necessary, deliveries will continue through the summer.
