June 4th Is Deadline To Enter FB Queen, Talent Contests

Contests, Little Miss Talent Find, June 11

The Colorado County Farm Bureau is now seeking entries for its Queen, Talent Find and Little Miss Parade. This year's contest is scheduled for Friday, June 11th at the Eagle Lake Middle School beginning at 8:00 p.m.

Eligible participants for the Queen contest must be 16-21 years of age by Sept. 1, 1982, be single (defined as never been married), and the daughter or sister of a Colorado County Farm Bureau member. Deadline for entries is June 4th.

Contestants will be judged on appearance, poise, personality, and speech, although other qualities such as grace and charm will be taken into account. They will be required to speak from one to two minutes on a Farm Bureau current event question.

Talent Competition Entries for the Colorado County Farm Bureau Talent Find contest are now also being accepted. The contest is scheduled for June 11 at the Eagle Lake Middle School, beginning at 8:00 p.m.

Participants in the contest must be between the ages of 16-21 as of Sept. 1, 1982 and single. They must be amateurs and Colorado County Farm Bureau members or members of a Colorado County Farm Bureau family.

Each entry is limited to five minutes and a penalty will be charged for overtime. When an accompanist is required, each entry should make his own arrangements.

Little Miss Parade Little girls between the ages of three and pre-school six as of June 11, 1982 are eligible for the Little Miss Parade. It will be held prior to the Queen's Contest and Talent Find.

to the Queen's Contest and Talent Find. Entries must be daughters of Colorado County Farm Bureau members and must not have participated in this event before. This is not a contest but merely a sneak preview of our future queen hopefuls.

Queen contestant, Talent Find contestant, and Little Miss participant entries are urged to contact the following before June 4, 1982: Columbus, Nalda Hunt; Weimar, Virginia Brandt; Eagle Lake, Nancy Adkins; Garwood, Lydia Engstrom; or the Colorado County Farm Bureau Office in Columbus.

Farm Bureau employees, dealers, service agents and their families and past State Queen winners are not eligible to enter.
