If uniting all the members of one community to a common goal is a noble enough, consider the consolidation of what were once three independent school districts into one. Rice Consolidated Independent School District Superintendent Harold King displays a keen sense of responsibility in his efforts to unite the three districts into one. "We are interested in what goes on here," The school cannot avoid pressure to have good programs. "We also have to concentrate on having good programs. In some instances, to correctly provide for the three different communities (Sheridan, Garwood and Eagle Lake). Being somewhat isolated, they sometimes lack common interests," said King. "They identify strongly. Although the emphasis is on fulfilling expectations, education is more difficult."

Superintendent sensitive to district needs

to measure for success and properly so, with their own schools. Rice High School is the largest school in the district. "Quantity and amount of education is always a bit vague," King said, "but we have to, I think, approach education in a similar fashion as other types of business. To have a quality product, you must have a quality process. To have a quality process, you must have a quality product."

While a lot has been said about low student achievement at all levels throughout the country, the superintendent views the problem as stemming from the very nature of teaching. "We are involved in mass education and we encounter all kinds of learning problems. We deal with a more complex situation than schools that choose whom they want to teach. We want our teachers to expect high achievement from our students. It is a reason that students without not be able to learn to read, write and do arithmetic."

King said he is going to expect students to learn those things, expect those students, and expect those students to teach those things. "If all of our parents, board of trustees, school administrators and teachers hold these expectations for students, then I'm convinced that more learning and achievement will occur."

The goal is to emphasize these expectations on every aspect of the school. "Strong personal must be employed and maintained, and improvement must be sought in areas where there are shortcomings. As the facilities become older, more attention is placed on proper maintenance. Also, money spent on maintenance is never wasted."

King also said that while the school is not a hand-drawn lot of attention, other programs do not meet the public eye. "I would encourage that the secondary programs are important and very successful, but if you look at the public eye, we need to seek ways to draw the same kind of attention to less dramatic programs."
