The cadet is a student at Texas A&M University, College Station.



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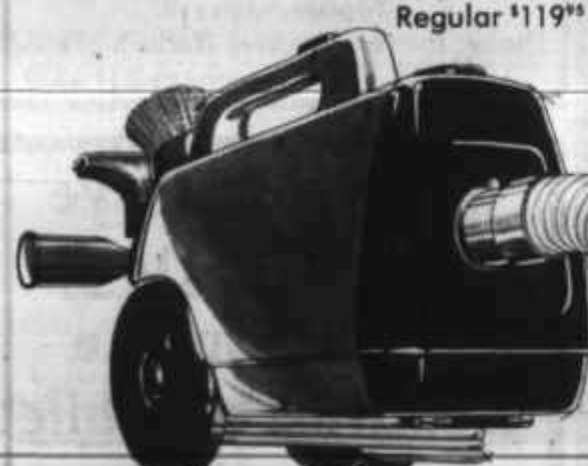
