Potatoes, Hero or Villain?
 The lowly potato has often been cast as a villain in the calorie control battle. But it is really a hero. A medium sized (about 1 1/2 lb.) contains about 35% of Vitamin C, 20% of Vitamin B6, 10% of Vitamin A and lots more, and contains only 100 calories.
 To get the most from the potatoes you buy, look for those that are fairly clean, firm and smooth. Avoid those that are wrinkled, have soft spots, (but not wet) dark place that is well ventilated, in the refrigerator.
 For Shiny "French Fries" cut 3 to 4 peeled or scrubbed potatoes into 1/4" strips. Keep in a bowl of ice water to crisp. Drain and pat dry. Spread potatoes in a single layer in a jelly-roll pan. Sprinkle with 2 tablespoons of vegetable oil. Sprinkle 30 to 40 minutes. Turn frequently. Sprinkle with paprika and season as desired. Sprinkle with *United States Recommended Dietary Allowance.

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Other budget matters involving various Eagle Lake area concerns receiving money from the county include an increase (from 1982 to 1983) of \$444 to \$4830 for the secretary for Justice of the Peace No. 8, M. M. Jones in Eagle Lake, who works 2.5 days a week; fire departments in Eagle Lake, \$4,000 to \$4,400; Sheridan, \$1,150 to \$1,265; Garwood, \$3,300 to \$3,630; and Rock Island, \$800 to \$880; Eagle Lake Winterman Library from \$2,500 to \$2,750; Sheridan Youth Library from \$1,150 to \$1,265; and Veterans Memorial Library in Garwood, \$1,725 to \$1,897.50.
