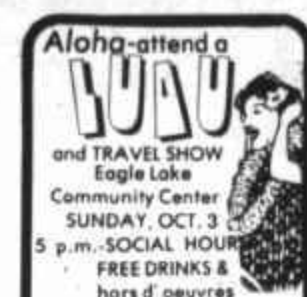

New funds source set for businesses

The Houston-Galveston Area Local Development Corporation, created by the elected-official Board of Directors of the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC), has been certified by the Small Business Administration.

The local development corporation, when it gets into full operation in a few weeks, will provide funds to start or expand small business through long-term loans at moderate interest rates in the 13-county region served by HGAC, which includes Colorado County.

Once it begins operations, the new corporation will work with private lenders in cooperative effort to provide loans for small business for capital investment. The Local Development Corporation will provide a 40 percent share of a loan from funds provided through the Small Business Administration. The small business loan would have to provide 10 percent of project costs with the remaining 50 percent provided by an area private lending institution.

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Griffith M. Thomas to 5-year residency

Forty-four physicians have been accepted in residency training programs at Scott and White Hospital in Temple.

Griffith M. Thomas, M.D., a native of Eagle Lake, Texas, will serve a 5-year residency at Scott and White in the department of general surgery. Thomas obtained his medical degree from the University of Texas at Houston, and a bachelors degree from Texas Lutheran College at Seguin, Texas.

Dr. Charles D. Morehead, Chairman of Scott and White's Research and Education Council, and Associate Dean of Texas A&M University's College of Medicine, explained that "the residency training period varies from three to five years depending on the specialty a resident chooses to enter."

He added that "upon graduation from the program, these physicians will have acquired from ten to thirteen years of education and clinical training which qualifies them to enter the practice of general surgery or a specialty field without supervision or in private or group practice."

Departments involved in the residency training program include internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, pathology, pediatrics, orthopedics, anesthesiology, ophthalmology, radiology, general surgery and urology.
