The Garwood-Sheridan Raiders made another fine showing last Thursday and tamed the Weimar Wildcats by the score of 22-0 for their third straight win of the season. The 7th and 8th grade combined team will host Sacred Heart of Schulerburg Thursday for a game in Sheridan with kick off at 5 p.m.

In the contest with Weimar Dean Faichtinger scored the first touchdown on a 46-yard option play with the extra points made by Lynn Montgomery on a dive play, to end that quarter at 8-0.

A 27-yard halfback pass completion from Faichtinger to Florencio Ramos scored the final touchdown which came in the third quarter, and the extra points were made by Montgomery to close scoring at 22-0.

Offensively, Faichtinger again led the Raiders with 97 total yards with Xavier Pratt adding 38, Greg King 29, Montgomery 23 and Ramos 15.

Coaches Bennie Machae and Mike Michalka listed the following as defensive standouts including Ramos with five tackles and four assists; Faichtinger, five assists, one tackle and one interception; Albert Lopez, six assists, one tackle and

The most popular play La Grange ran was around either end where they could easily score by missing backfield tacklers and then outdistancing the Raider downfield defense.

The day before the game, Darden told the Eagle Lake Lions club members he was changing defense tactics. Instead of having the corner players responsible for defending both pass and running plays, they would simply have rush defense responsibility. Players behind the

defense line would be responsible for passes coming their way. In previous games, Darden said the corners were having trouble reading opposition plays as they developed. "A play would look run all the way and end up in a pass," he said.

However, nothing seemed to help as the La Grange Leopards looked great on their home field, moving the ball at will.

On the Rice side, mental mistakes seemed to be down, with only a few penalties called in the game. One long pass from quarterback Mel Pratt to Phillip Schorlemmer was called back because of Rice holding.

The Raiders did lead in the ball game after they scored a touchdown with 3:35 left to play in the first

quarter when Pratt handed off to Dwayne Pagel who ran it in. Rob Johnson's extra point kick was good and Rice was ahead 7-6.

The Leopard score came with little more than three minutes ticked off the clock, but they failed on their extra point kick.

Raider offense looked good on their scoring series, which started on their own 30 yard line. They earned a first down on their first play, and on the second were only inches short of another. During the series, the team made two more first downs.

But it took La Grange only six plays to move the ball 70 yards and score again, making it 13-7, in La Grange's favor.

In the second quarter, although Rice held the ball

for a long series of plays, they were forced to punt.

But good Rice defensive play caused a La Grange fumble which Pagel recovered. Four plays later, with a fourth down and one yard to go situation, Rice returned the favor and fumbled the ball back to the Leopards.

They capitalized, running the ball over the left end for an 85 yard score.

Rice was never able to recover and although they scored again, never regained the lead.

The Rice Raiders will face Sealy on their home field in Altair at 7:30 p.m. Friday. Last week, Sealy was beaten by Columbus 10-8.



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
