## Area priests attend conference

Five area Catholic priests attended the 37th annual Town and Country Church Conference for clergy and laity, October 4-5th at Texas A&M University in College Station.

Theme was "Cautious, Texas is Changing!" The church's response was "Allentation or Reconciliation?" by Bishop John L. Fitzpatrick, Bishop of Catholic Diocese of Brownsville.

A special feature was the annual "Rural Minister's Day" held on Monday evening at 6:30 p.m. in the Methodist Student Center, Texas A&M. The Rev. William J. Hughes of Jourdan was named the "1982 Texas Rural Minister of the Year."

The award was presented by Del Detering, editor, Progressive Farmer magazine, Dallas.

Former rural ministers of the year were recognized by Jack Jones. Among them was Rev. Msgr. Victor G. Schmidtinsky, St. Mary's Church, Nada, Texas Rural Minister of 1981, when pastor of St. Andrew's Church in Pleasanton.

## Low-income households may apply for energy assistance payments

Applications to be taken here Tuesday

The Combined Community Action Agency has contracted with the Texas Department of Human Resources to provide assistance to low-income families.

According to Steve Quitta, Jr., Executive Director of CCA, funds will be used to intervene in an energy crisis situation in which households experience a cutoff of energy supply for heating or cooling their homes. Payments will be made to the energy supplier on behalf of eligible households.

"Due to limited funding, we will be serving households that apply on a first-come, first-served basis," said Steve Quitta, Jr.

Eligibility for the program is based on the total gross monthly household income, citizenship and need. To be eligible, households must have an income equal to or less than \$305 for a one-person household; \$499 for a two-person household; \$645 for four, and \$908 for five. Also, households must be in an energy cutoff situation.

A maximum of \$90 is available to eligible households once every six months (October 1982-March 1983 and April, 1983-September 1983) as long as funds are available.

Mr. Quitta said that persons applying for the program should have proof of income for all household members for the 30 days after application. This may be a paycheck stub, public assistance check or unemployment check. They

should also have the social security number of all household members earning income, and their notice of termination of energy supply. Proof of citizenship is also required.

Combined Community Action staff will be taking applications in Colorado County the third week of November at the following locations:

November 16: Eagle Lake City Hall, 100 East Main Street, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

November 17: Weimar City Hall, 106 East Main Street, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

## Insurance, roads among commission action

Residents angry over conditions of County Road 101, and the approval of bids for fire insurance, were among the 29 items on the Colorado County Commissioners Court agenda Monday.

The 10 a.m. meeting adjourned at noon after a 10-minute session of the items.

Seven signatures were on a petition presented to commissioners, that had a letter attached from the region seven office of the Texas Air Control Board concerning the violation of air standards along the road.

The road in question was a blacktopped before B&B Gravel Company began a mining operation in the area. It now is a clay and gravel road, according to the petition.

According to petitioner, Alice Tait, Joe Hanak, Robert Earl Walters, and Joe, Jesse, Clarence and Henry Potter, the road was converted from its blacktop condition to county taxpayers expense, to serve the needs of the

mining operations. Such action has caused four problems, they claim:

Dust from the trucks is one, and the air quality board agreed, saying there was a "violation of TACB rules" of nuisance dust air pollution. The board asked precinct one commissioners to "Please consider the problem" and to let them know what the commissioner's plans are for dealing with it.

The petitioners also complained about drainage problems, the traffic problem because of the increased traffic and trucks parking on the road waiting to get into the mining site, and about a pipeline they claim B&B under the road without proper permission or provision for erosion which has caused a depression at that point in the road.

They asked the commissioners court to require the company to resurface the road with new blacktop, but commissioner Loessin said the
