Raider boys beat Columbus

Although details were sketchy, the Rice Raider boys basketball team came out on top of rival Columbus by one point last week to take the Needville Tournament championship 53 to 52.

The Raiders and Columbus were in opposing brackets of the three-day tournament, and met Saturday night in the finals. Because of the school holidays this week, Coach Jack Grammer was not available for comment.

There were four Raiders in double figures for the championship game. Delbert Jarvis and Rob Johnson each had 12. Rodney Parker scored 11 and Stanley Powell finished with 10.

Powell and Parker both were named to the all-tournament team.

To get to the finals, Rice first beat Boling 80-70 on Thursday night. Parker hit for 19 points, Powell had 17 and Jarvis hit for 15.

Friday in the semi-finals, the Raiders were victorious over Santa Fe, 73 to 59. Parker had a high of 21 points and Powell had 18.

The next game for the Raiders is Thursday, December 30, in Brenham.

Raider girls whip Waller; third in Yoakum tourney

In the past week the Rice Raider girls have taken on the Waller teams, taking all three contests; failed to place in the La Grange Tournament but brought home the third place trophy in the Yoakum Tournament.

In the contests with Waller on December 14th, the freshmen defeated their rivals 35 to 6 with Veronica Woods scoring 14 and Stray White eight. The Junior Varsity won by the score 28 to 24 with Janet Scott high point Raider with 12 and Charlotte King adding 10. The Varsity whopped their Waller opponents 64 to 36 as Rosharon Foster dunked 21 points and Mablean Bluntson 14.

On December 9, 10 and 11 the Raider Varsity girls participated in the La Grange Tournament, losing their first game to Brenham by the heart-breaking score of 36 to 35. In the second game the Raiders were victorious over Giddings, but narrowly, as the final score was 50 to 49 in favor of Rice. Rice's third game was with West Lake of Austin. West Lake's 42 final score compared to Rice's 28 put the local team out of the competition.

Last weekend the Raiders journeyed to the Yoakum Tournament, and after the third game won the third place trophy. In the first game the Raiders outscored Luling by the score 48 to 37 with the scoring by quarters as follows: Rice 7, 23, 35 and 48 compared to Luling's 15, 19, 29 and 37. Mablean Bluntson was high scoring Raider in this contest with 18 points as Kim Wunderlich added nine.

In Rice's second game in the tournament, they took on Gonzales but lost narrowly 44 to 41. Scoring by quarters included: Rice 5, 23, 32 and 41; Gonzales 17, 29, 34 and 44. Kim Wunderlich was the leading Raider with 21 and Bluntson added 13.

After topping Edna 39 to 38 in the third game, the Raiders were declared winners of the third place trophy. Scoring by quarters went as follows: Rice 7, 18, 27 and 39; Edna 10, 24, 30 and 38. Wunderlich scored 15 points and Bluntson 12 in this contest.

On December 28th the Junior Varsity and Varsity will travel to Luling for two contests beginning at 5 p.m. The next action will pit the Raider Varsity against La Grange at Raider Stadium January 4th at 6:30 p.m., and on the same day the freshmen and JV teams will go to La Grange.

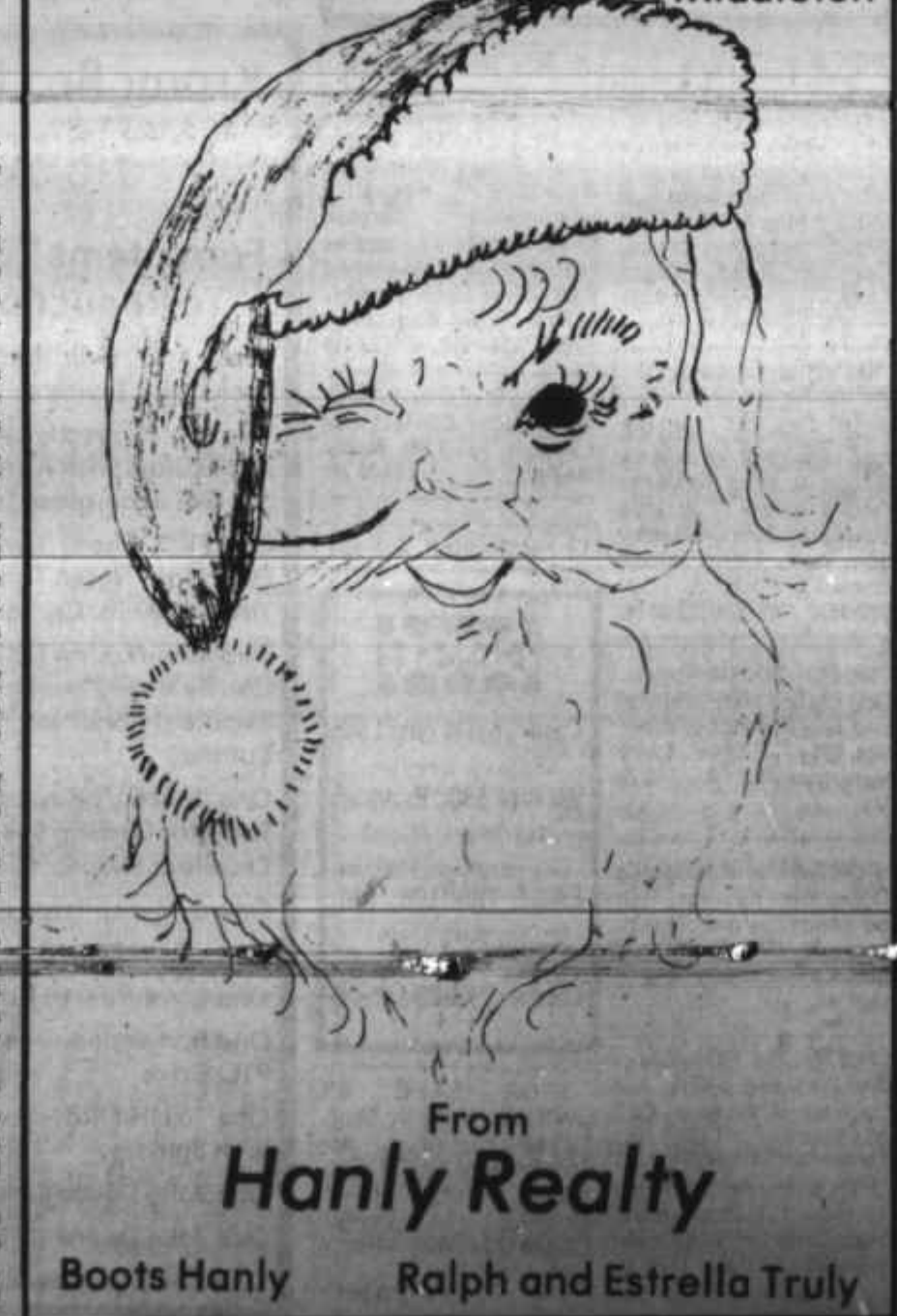
