## Agricultural Observations

More dry weather is likely past and small grains recover from the recent low temperatures. Stockmen may have to keep supplemental feeds in stock since grazing areas will take some time to recover. There is also plenty of time for more cool weather to occur and feed supplies may be needed later on. Mild temperatures and sunshine will help maintain drying for the next several days and improve topsoil for yield activity. No further delays are in sight at this time.
