Wiese, Marburger exchange vows

The United Methodist Church of Eagle Lake was the setting for the candle-light ceremony uniting Miss Denise Carol Wiese and Robert Cecil Marburger, Jr. in marriage Saturday, February 26 at seven o'clock in the evening.
