Soil testing pays for pastures

It's not too late to get your pasture soil tested so you can reap bigger benefits from your fertilization dollars. Far from being an added expense in pasture management, a soil test is a useful management tool based on the profit motive.

A soil test is a chemical analysis of a soil sample to determine the level of plant nutrients available in the soil. The most common information provided by a soil test is the soil reaction (the pH level—basic or acid).

Organic matter content, and predicted levels of nitrogen, phosphorus, potassium, calcium and possibly salt.

Most soil test reports will include fertilizer recommendations based on test results and geared for high production levels of the indicated crop. Soil test recommendations are based on long-term research and production records for each forage or crop involved.

By knowing plant nutrient levels in the soil, a fertilizer program can be planned that will include only needed elements. Eliminating elements already plentiful in the soil from a fertility program can save money that might be needlessly spent if the

program was "guessed at." For a soil test to be most useful, we suggest running a test on each individual pasture. Separate soil tests are needed only on large pastures with different soil types.

Run a soil test on a representative soil sample to be most accurate. That does not mean a shovel full of soil from an average part of the pasture but a composite of several soil samples throughout the pasture.

An easy way to remember to collect a representative soil sample from a pasture is to picture an "X" on the field. Take small samples (1 inch square and 6 inches deep) at the center of the "X" and at all four ends of the "X". Thus, the representative soil sample will be a mixture of smaller samples from five spots in the pasture.

Under intensive use, yearly soil tests may be necessary, but soil testing every two or three years is usually adequate. Comparing new results with old results provides an indication of nutrient buildup or usage, and fertility programs can be adjusted accordingly. Therefore, the soil test

becomes a useful part of pasture management, both short-term and long-term. An increasing number of Colorado county pasture soil tests are returning with recommendations calling for reduced levels of phosphorus. This is due to a soil phosphorus buildup from phosphorous fertilizers.

There is a major increase in the number of soil test results calling for major applications of potash. Recommendations on the lighter soils of 60-80 pounds of potash are commonplace with extremes of up to 120 pounds per acre. The bermuda's are heavy users of potash. Failure to maintain an adequate level will encourage a decline in your bermuda turf. Production of forage will be reduced dramatically.

In the absence of current soil test results, producers use a 3-12 ratio fertilizer on their pasture and forage crops. This is a poor substitute for a soil test but will be a far better guess than using the standard 1-1-1 ratio fertilizers.

To get started on the road to soil sampling, stop by the county Extension office for soil sample boxes and information sheets.

Tony Lama Endurance Ride May 7

The First Annual Tony Lama Texas Endurance Ride has been set for May 7, 1983. It will be held in the Davy Crockett National Forest near Ludkin, Texas. The ride is AERC sanctioned, out of the American Endurance Ride Conference office which is based in Auburn, California.

Endurance Riding is done over cross-country trails with natural obstacles such as water, fallen logs, gullies, and mountains, depending on the local terrain. The West and Northwest areas of the United States have been extremely active in this sport for many years. The Tevis Cup Ride, also known as the Western States Trail Ride, is the agreed upon Granddaddy and "original" Endurance Ride. It's held every year during a full moon in July, (they ride all night). The winning times in the last few years have all been under 12 hours. The most amazing fact is that the full

100 miles is done of one animal is used because horses, mules or jennets are acceptable entries.

Texas is just now getting active with their own version of Endurance Riding. This will be the third year for sanctioned rides to take place in Texas. The Armadillo 50 is held in October of each year and the Tony Lama Texas 50 which will be the spring ride, is held May 7.

There will be a 25 mile Novice Ride held in conjunction with the 50 mile for those persons or horses who are not ready to tackle a 50 mile ride yet.

Most any breed of horse is able, with just light conditioning, to make the 25 mile ride. At least 30 to 60 days of conditioning is recommended for the 50 mile ride. The ride is supervised by qualified Veterinarians, who take pulse, respiration, and observe the horses for fatigue throughout the race. Any horses not showing proper recovery at the rest stops are not allowed to continue the race.

There are very few rules other than the prohibition of any kind of drugs and the recovery at rest stops, which make this a very simple yet exciting sport for horse enthusiasts who may be tired of going round and round in a show ring, or only having a few seconds to win or lose in a rodeo arena.
