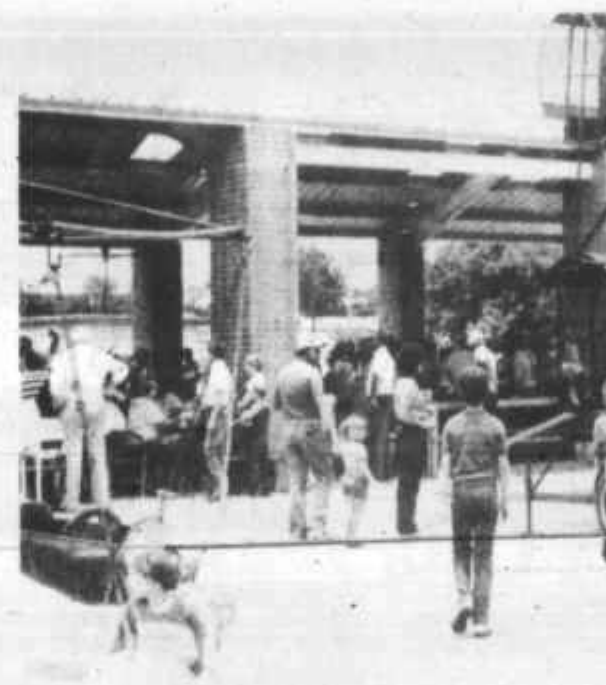

The periwinkle is finding its way into more and more yards and gardens each summer because its tough and heat tolerant, says a landscape horticulturist with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service.

In addition, periwinkles come in a variety of colors and have narrow, dark-green, glossy leaves which will give a boost to any yard or garden where other plants may languish.
