



Easy-Do Banana Bread

pkg. yellow cake mir 1/2 cup evaporated milk 2 slightly beaten eggs

2 tsp. vanilla

1/4 cup cooking oil

\_1 cup (2 or 3) well-mashed bana 1/r tsp. soda 1/r cup shredded coconut or chopped nuts

3/4 cup fine graham cracker crumbs

Combine first seven ingredients in large mixer bowl Beat on low speed until well blended. Do not overbeat; mix only until smooth. Quickly mix in nuts or coconut and raham cracker crumbs. Pour into well greased and oured loaf pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour or until loaf tests done. Avoid overbrowning top by use of a foil cover for final 20 minutes. Serve plain or sift confectioner's sugar over top.

"Sandhill cranes are surprisingly meaty and tasty if prepared right," said Ron George, sandhill crane program leader for the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department. "A live crane weighs seven to 10 pounds and will yield three to five pounds of tender, lean fillets from the breast and

George hastens to remind unters that federal law equires the retention of one fully feathered wing on all dressed cranes until the hunter reaches his residence , or a commercial

processing facility. Almost any good water-fowl recipe will work fine or cooking sandhill cranes, but I have found the best method is cooking fillets slowly in a crockpot with either mushroom, soup. arbecue sauce, an otatoes, carrots and onons," George commented


