Governor Mark White found himself on the political hot seat last week for what has been pictured as lavish expenditures of both state and political campaign funds.

The criticism in the press followed on the heels of White's, and other public officials', quarterly financial reports required by law.

White came under fire for different reasons:

Republican party chairman George Strake, a natural foe, said White could have pared \$1 million in frills from the \$3.1 million cost of his new, foreign-made jet which will carry White on official state business.
