

Recipe of the Week

Texas pecan pie



3 eggs
1 cup sugar
1/8 teaspoon salt
3 tablespoons flour
1 cup white corn syrup
1 cup pecans
1/4 cup butter, softened

Beat eggs well. Combine sugar, salt, and flour; beat into eggs. Gradually add corn syrup, beating well. Add pecans and soft butter. Stir in vanilla. Pour into unbaked pastry shell. Bake in hot oven (400 degrees) 15 minutes; lower temperature to moderate (350 degrees), bake 30 to 35 minutes, or until set and pastry is nicely browned. Cool. Top each serving with a whirl of whipped cream if you wish.

Baylor coach to speak in East Bernard

Baylor University football coach Grant Teaff will be the main speaker at the annual Booster Club Banquet honoring the East Bernard High School football team and volleyball team.

The banquet is March 22 at 7 p.m. at the American Legion Hall south of East Bernard. Tickets are \$1.50 and must be purchased in advance. Since Coach Teaff came to Baylor, the Bears have compiled a high impressive record. From Snyder, Texas, he won SWC Coach-of-the-Year honors in 1972 and he repeated the feat two years later when his Bears produced what was called "The Miracle on the Brazos" as they won the school's first league title in 80 years and went on to the Cotton Bowl for the first time.

Teaff is known as an outstanding speaker. He and his wife, Doreen, a former Texas Tech cheerleader, have three daughters.
