Irish Cream Chocolate Chip Cookies

1/2 cup butter  
1/2 cup granulated sugar  
1/2 cup brown sugar  
1 egg  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
1/2 cup Baileys Original Irish Cream

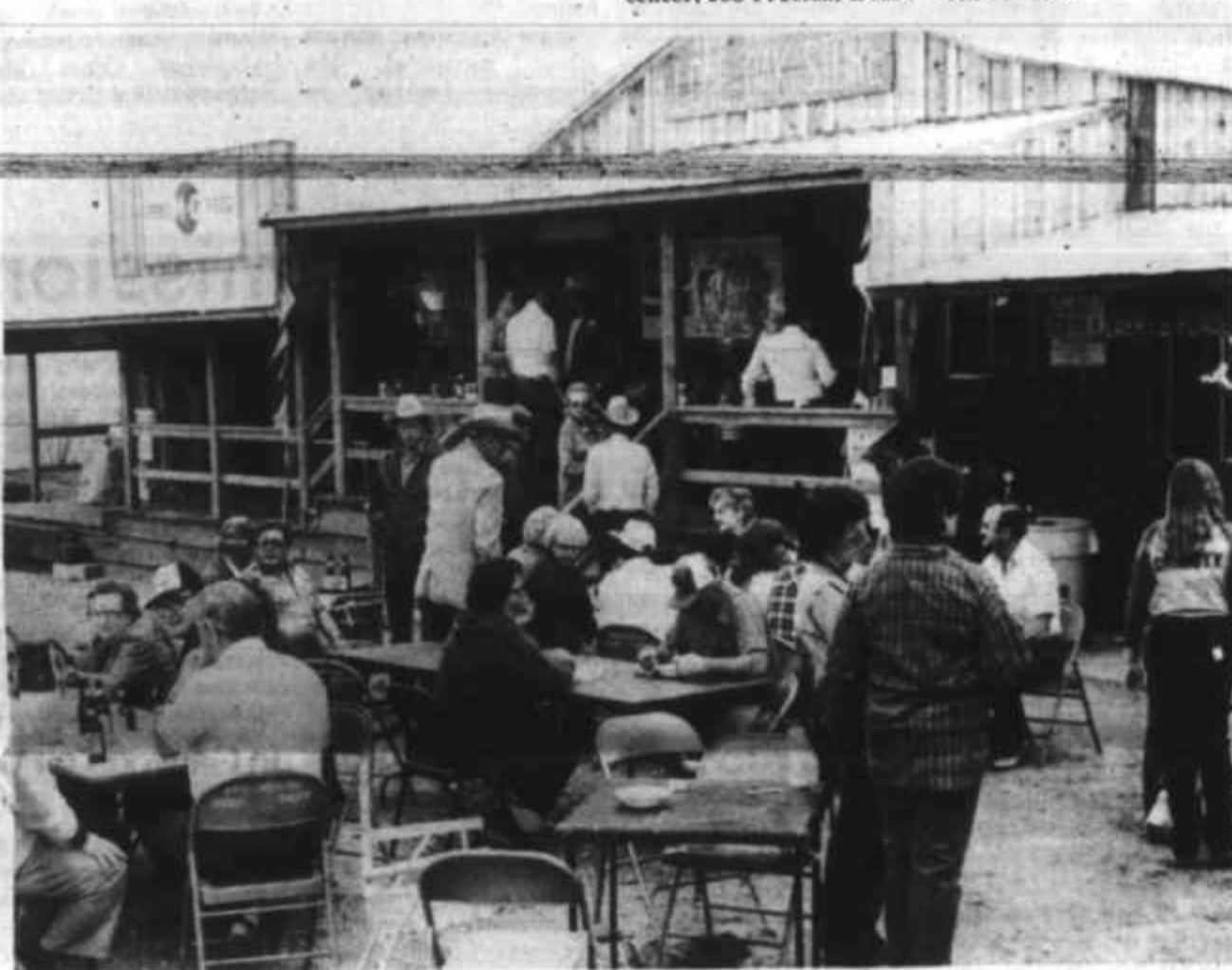
