Recipe of the Week

Banana Split Cake

Crust:
 1 box vanilla wafers (crushed)
 1 stick oleo (melted)
 Mix together and press into 13x9 pan.

Then mix:
 1 lb. box powdered sugar
 1 - 8 oz. cream cheese (softened)

Mix and beat until smooth and spread over crust. Next, arrange 3 sliced bananas, No. 2 can of crushed pineapple (drained) and 1 large bowl cool whip. After topped with cool whip, pour some chocolate syrup over and top with chopped pecans and cherries. Chill.

County Agent's Notebook

Fertilize farm ponds for more fish

Fertilizer can double or triple fish yields from farm ponds, and now is the time to apply it. An inorganic fertilizer is the best choice, with granular 20-20-5 at the rate of 50 pounds per surface acre or liquid 16-32-0 at the rate of 1 gallon per surface acre most often recommended.

For best results with granular formulations, pour the fertilizer directly onto sunken platforms. If this method is not feasible, split the sacks and place the fertilizer in shallow water. Fertilizer may be poured directly into water less than 3 feet deep.

If a liquid formulation is used, dilute each gallon of fertilizer with 10 gallons of water and pour directly into the pond.

Water in the pond should develop a greenish color, indicating a phytoplankton bloom, about four to six weeks after the first application of fertilizer. Phytoplankton increases the amount of food chain and therefore produces more pounds of fish.

To maintain a phytoplankton bloom with granular fertilizer, apply 20-30 pounds of 20-20-5 per surface whenever a shiny object is visible in the water less than 18 inches from the surface. Liquid fertilizer applications of 1 gallon per surface acre will be needed about every two weeks to maintain the bloom. Stop fertilizing with the onset of hot weather.
