**Delta Savings holds ribbon cutting**

Residents of Eagle Lake attended a ribbon cutting ceremony for Delta Savings of Texas Friday, March 23.

Delta's Eagle Lake branch opened its doors last month and since then has been conducting a contest for ten \$100 savings accounts. The winners' names were drawn after the ceremony Friday.

The branch manager of the savings and loan is Cindy Gohlke, a former resident of Sheridan and a graduate of Sheridan High School. Cindy said she requested the position in Eagle Lake because she likes the area and wants to be near her family.

Cindy was first employed by Delta Savings almost six years ago, as a teller. Since then, she has worked her way up to her present position, and she said, "I'm glad to be back in the area."

**Permits granted for new pipelines**

Railroad Commission chairman Mack Wallace has announced that 30 permits to operate new pipelines in Texas were granted by the RRC in February, while 12 were granted in February 1983.

Twenty-four of the new permits were for gathering pipelines, four were for trunk transmission lines and two were for other types of lines. Gathering lines bring oil and gas from production leases, while a trunk transmission line is a larger diameter line into which smaller lines connect.

Twenty-nine of the newly-permitted lines will transport natural gas and one will carry carbon dioxide.

In February, seven permits were granted to operate pipelines in the Refugio area (District 2); six in deep South Texas (District 4); five in the Midland area (District 8); and one each in East Central Texas (District 5), East Texas (District 6), and the San Angelo (District 7C) and Lubbock (District 8A) areas.

Gathering lines approved: Victoria Gas Corp., Corpus Christi, gas, two lines, both in Victoria county; Texas Gas Corp., Corpus Christi, gas, two lines, one in Freestone county and one in Nueces county; Retwell Corp., Abilene, gas, Jones county; Partner Energy Inc., Dallas, gas, Hood County; Kurten Gathering Inc., Houston, gas, Brazos county; Argonaut Energy Corp., Amarillo, gas, Lipscomb county; Joseph T. Dawson, Corpus Christi, gas, Nueces county; Kodiak Construction and Management Inc., Sherman, gas, Brown county; Paisano Transmission Co., George West, gas, two lines, both in Live Oak county.

Esenjay Petroleum Corp., Corpus Christi, gas, San Patricio county; Stephen W. Anderson Energy, Denver, Colorado, gas, Sutton county; May Petroleum Inc., Dallas, gas, Lipscomb county; Mobil Production Texas & New Mexico Inc., Houston, gas, Mitchell county; Production Acquisition Co., Houston, gas, Colorado county; American Pipeline Co., Houston, gas, seven lines, one each in Wharton, Jim Hogg, Lavaca, Colorado, Brooks, and Nacogdoches counties and one in Jim Wells and Duval counties.

Trunk transmission lines approved: Ennergas Co., Amarillo, gas, Potter county; Gabriel Prospect Pipeline Inc., Spring, gas, two lines in Goliad county; American Pipeline Co., Houston, gas, Harris county.

Multi-purpose and other lines approved: Markland Pipeline Co., Dallas, carbon dioxide, Bailey, Cochran, Hockley, Farmer and Yoakum counties.

**Caution children on vicious dogs**

Already in 1984 there has been a large number of serious dog bite cases in Public Health Region 11's area, including Colorado, Austin, Waller, Montgomery, Walker, Harris, Fort Bend, Wharton, Matagorda, Brazoria, Galveston, Chambers and Liberty counties, of responsibility. Many of these have been inflicted by the American Staffordshire Terrier or by the American Pit Bull Terrier commonly known as the "Pit Bull."

Because this breed has great biting and body strength it is commonly bred to fight in the pit. As a result when they bite someone it causes significant body damage.

All dog owners have a legal responsibility to take necessary precautions to prevent their dogs from biting anyone. However, parents have the responsibility to educate their children to not try to be friendly with all neighborhood dogs and if they know of a pit bull or other vicious dogs in their neighborhood to caution their children about the danger of getting too close to these dogs.
