The Lissie United Methodist Church was the setting for the candlelight wedding uniting Miss Rhonda Susan Gertson and Richard Paul Kramr in marriage at seven o'clock in the evening, Saturday, June 2, 1984.

Escorted to the altar and given in marriage by her father, the bride was lovely in her Milady gown of candlelight silk organza and English net featuring a portrait neckline. Her Victorian sleeves fell to V-notched cuffs closed with tiny covered buttons. The traditional gown was designed with Schiffler embroidered lace on the neck, sleeves and train. Venetian lace and seed pearls adorned the bodice and cascaded over the skirt.

From the dropped waistline the graceful skirt fell to slipper length to

form a cathedral length train accented with Schiffler embroidered lace and trimmed with a deep ruff of embroidered lace. To complete her attire the bride chose a Juliet cap of Venetian lace. 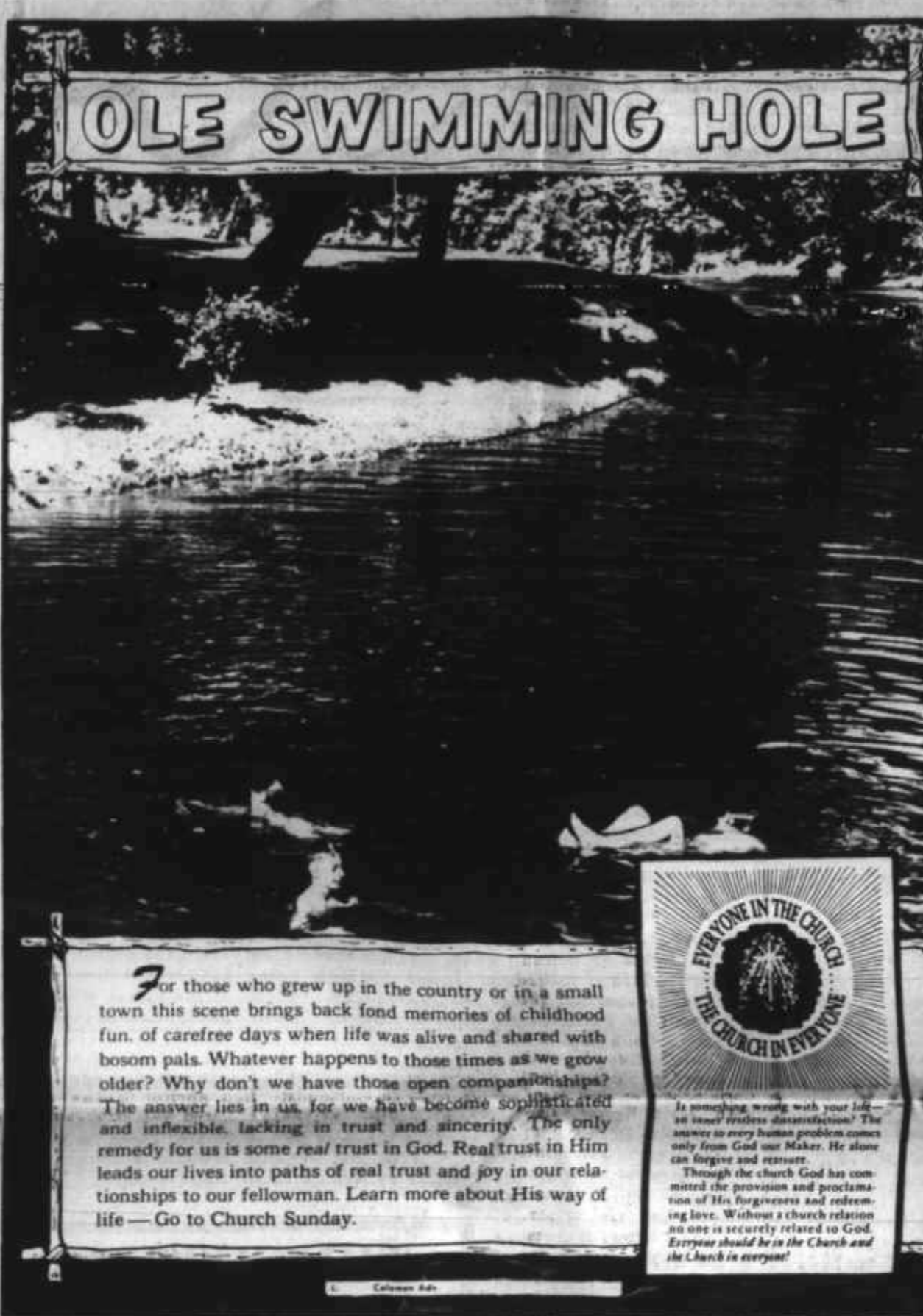
