Youens sponsor 'post' Water Safari Race party

Most of the top marathon canoe racers in Texas gathered at the home of Mrs. Harry Youens in Columbus on Saturday, the 14th of July, for their annual Texas Water Safari post-race party. The Texas Water Safari, billed as the "World's Toughest Canoe Race" is the longest human-powered boat race in the world. It is held the first weekend in June.

The race course covers 419 kilometers of river from San Marcos, in the hill country, to the coastal community of Seadrift, and is run non-stop — night and day. After 63-85 hours of shooting whitewater, portaging dams, winding through coastal swamps, and battling storm-tossed bays, without sleep or rest, it is little wonder that the contestants take out a month and a half to heal up before gathering again to socialize.

The race, which draws the United States, Canada and Great Britain, was won this year by Jerry Nunneery and Roy Tyrone of Friendswood. Some familiar faces in the group for Columbus were Tom Stallman and Rob Youens, both of whom have repeatedly placed very high in the race standings, but have yet to win the coveted first place trophy.

The post-race party, organized by Youens, was a family gathering for the competitors and their families who seldom can visit during the grueling training periods before the race. It was a tremendous success.

One topic discussed at the meeting, which should be of special interest to local residents, who want to promote their friendly town and its beautiful river, was the prospect of moving a state canoe race to the Colorado river at Columbus' central location could give it the state, in the very near future...not including the Texas Water Safari, of course.
