

## Wright completes theatre workshop at University of Texas

Douglas R. Wright, academic counselor and drama coach at Rice High School, has completed eight credit hours of coursework as part of the twenty-second annual Summer Theatre Workshop held at the department of drama, College of Fine Arts, The University of Texas at Austin. The workshop was under the direction of Mr. Lynn Murry, state drama director in the University of Texas Interscholastic League. Wright was one of seven outstanding drama teachers in Texas invited to participate in this year's theatre in a Parched Ground.

Fifty-three gifted and talented drama students from across the state of Texas participated in the six-week long workshop. Wright received high praise for his directing skills in two laboratory plays, "Little Foxes" and "Stage Door." He also rehearsed plays as well as class and laboratory acting scenes and plays for the past six weeks. They have used hammers, saws, needles, scissors, brushes, pliers, rulers and squares. They have worked with nails, screws, lumber, cloth, electric cables, tape records and stage rigging. They have studied acting, directing, dramatic literature, techniques, speaking voice, stagecraft, makeup and dance.

"These students have learned why it is important to be on time, to assume responsibility, to work in close harmony with others, to give as well as to take orders, to subordinate self to the welfare of the group when needed and to respect rightfully used authority."

"All this they experienced in the workshop and in the three major plays in the well equipped educational theatre, the B. Iden Payne Theatre located within the F. Loren Winslip drama building on the university campus. When there is even a modestly equipped theatre, the variety of educational opportunities for students is unexcelled by any other program in the school. These opportunities should be available to every Texas high school student."

"This workshop is part of the fast-growing nationwide program that finds theatre, richly recognized by that title, as a curricular subject in secondary school fine arts programs. In Texas, theatre classes are taught by instructors who today must be well qualified to teach 'education theatre' as are teachers of any other subject."

"Given the same attention that school boards and administrators accord other school programs, high school theatre will provide quantitatively and qualitatively superior education to the largest possible number of high school students."

## Registration set for Friday at St. Mary's School

Registration has been set for Friday, August 3, from 9 a.m. to noon at St. Mary's Parish Hall in Nada. The first day of school will be August 22.

Registration fee is \$12 per child, parishioner or non-parishioner. Tuition is \$15 per month per child or \$20 per family (two or more) per month for children living in Nada. Tuition for non-parishioners (those living outside of St. Mary's Parish in Nada) is \$30 per month per child or \$40 per family (two or more children) per month.

Bus fare is \$7.50 per family per month for parishioners and the fare for Eagle Lake children will be more. Lunches will cost 80 cents per child for all students in first and second grades and 65 cents for all students from third through eighth grade.

St. Mary's School has a full slate of qualified teachers which will be announced in the special school section to run in the Eagle Lake Headlight August 9.

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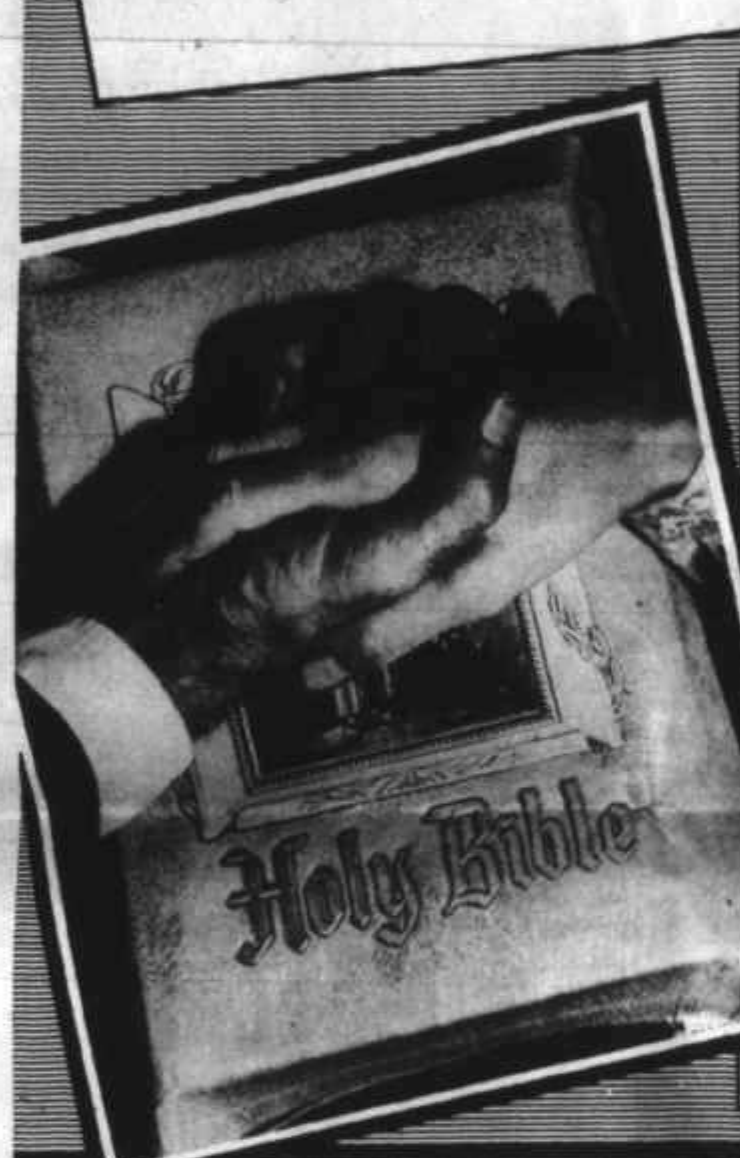
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## The TIE that Binds...
