CPL customers to pay less for electricity

Central Power and Light Company customers will soon be paying less for electricity. According to Charles Garrett, CPL local manager, the Public Utility Commission has approved the company's request to reduce the fuel cost factor, which accounts for the major portion of the electric bill.

In ruling on the company's request to lower the fuel factor, the hearing examiner concluded that the commission has exclusive and original jurisdiction in setting the lower factor for all CPL customers.

"Early last December we asked the commission's approval to lower the fuel portion of the customer's bill by reducing the fuel cost factor applied to customers' bills since October 1983," Garrett said.

The company is also seeking to refund \$16.6 million in fuel over-recoveries, which have been collected through September 1984. Application of a commission-prescribed formula caused the over-recovery. The PUC hearing examiner took no action on the refund, but indicated the issue will be taken up during hearings in Austin scheduled for March 4.

ter, Langford said, can produce the first.

The city has quite a lot going already, Hankamer said, and while results will take time, it shouldn't take much time to start talking to prospects.

To close their report, the two planners gave council a proposed resolution that re-enforces the city's support of the industrial foundation's work that creates an economic development team, and gives the team power to negotiate for the city, subject to council's final approval.

Mayor Struss suggested adoption of the resolution be postponed until Feb. 11, Bill Harrison Jr. and Don Bendy, presidents of the industrial foundation and chamber of commerce, urged a "straw vote" be made. Each councilman said they would vote for its adoption at the next meeting.

In other business, council voted its approval to give Struss authority to sign, on behalf of the city, a contract with the Wintemann Library. The contract is a legal necessity, and only puts on paper the relationship the city has had with the library since 1977, Struss told council.

Council also voted to advertise for bids for a new police car, and took action to join with other cities to intervene in the CPL rate case before the Public Utilities Commission.
