The market this week was again stronger on all. Steer calves continue to sell very strong on the lighter weights and the yearling classes according to George Hagen and Don McAlister.

Stocker Cows: good stocker cows and heifers, 47 to 53 cents per pound, commercial and purebred stocker cows and heifers, 42 to 49 cents per pound; good cow and calf pairs, \$500

Cattle on hand, 1016; hogs, 10; sheep, 4; horses, 4.

Packer Cows: higher demand utility and center cows, 43 to 47.50 cents per pound; lower dressing utility and center cows, 37 to 43 cents per pound; utility and about, 30 to 37 cents.

Packer Bulls: heavy weight, 55 to 57 cents per pound; utility and about, 45 to 50 cents.

Sheep: common cash call prices, \$375 to \$450.

Hogs: No. 3 butchers, 40 to 50 cents; No. 2 and 4, 35 to 40 cents; No. 1 and 5, 30 to 35 cents.

Sheep: ewes, 8 to 10 cents; lambs, 10 to 12 cents; wethers, 5 to 6 cents; pairs, 30 to \$50.

National meat we

Butcher, Calves and Yearlings: good to choice, \$7 to 61.50 cents per pound; standard, 50 to 55 cents; utility, 50 to 54 cents.

Stealer and Feeder Calves and Yearlings: Steer and Bull calves 300-500 pounds, \$8 cents to \$11.10; 500-600 cents, \$7 to 8 cents; Heifer calves 300-500 pounds, \$9 to 10 cents; 500-600 pounds, \$8 to 9 cents; 600-700 pounds, \$7 to 8 cents; 700-800 pounds, \$6 to 7 cents; Heifer calves 500-600 pounds, \$5 to 6 cents; 600-700 pounds, \$4 to 5 cents.
