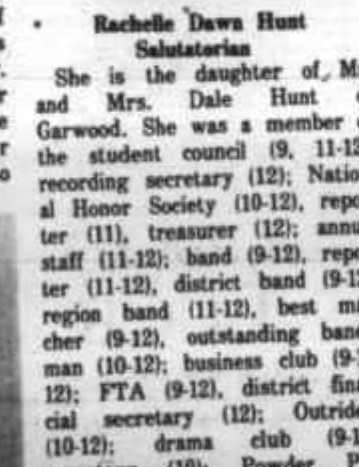
Mary Esther Hernandez

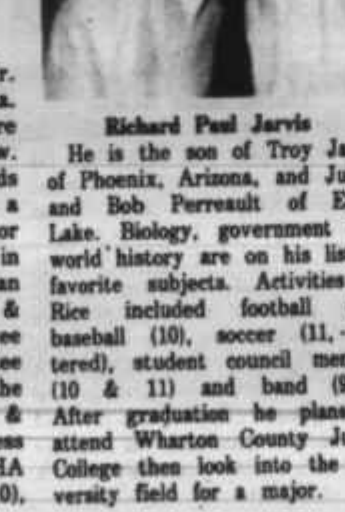
Toni Jaramillo

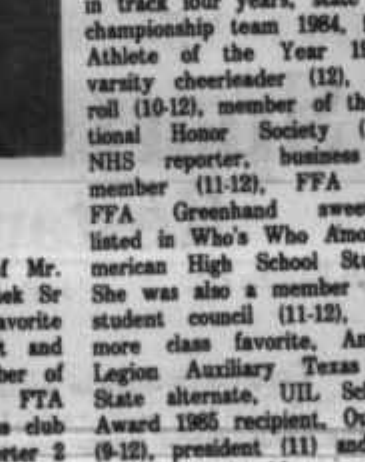

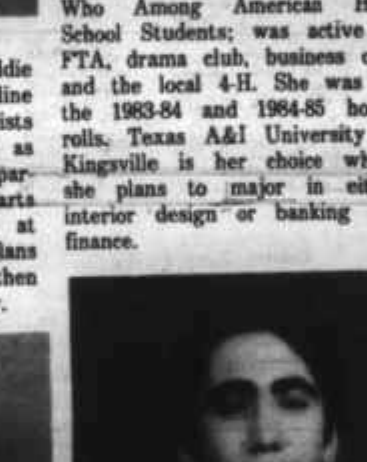


Ronny Little

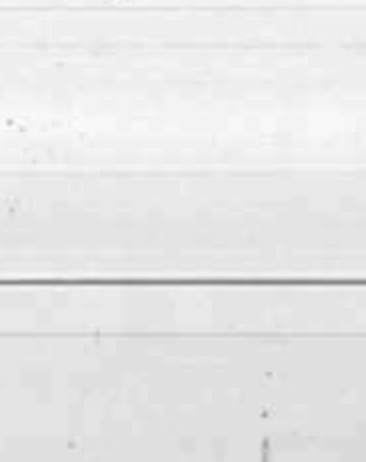
Michelle Milligan
