James Lee Williamson

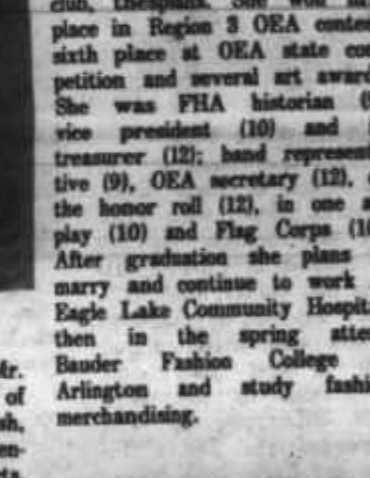
