Rice FFA chapter members last Thursday added another improvement to their facilities at Rice High School, thanks to James Brune and Ray Cumberworth of Superior Sand and Gravel, Alfred Prihoda and Son, Wilfred Luedcke and Franka Huvar. Behind the showbarn, chapter members have created a new pen area that will allow them to hold and work their cattle, instead of hauling them elsewhere when their animals need vaccinations, castration, worming, dehorning and other show preparations. In the cemented area students designed a permanent location for weighing scales. All in all, the new facilities would have cost about \$5,000, but thanks to the donations, the chapter spent only about \$1,700 of its money on pipe. Superior donated the sand and gravel, Prihoda donated the fill dirt, Luedcke donated the cement mix, the mixing truck and then donated the time to pour it. When school resumes next fall, students will use the pipe Huvar gave them to build a weather cover for the area.
