School Board

Vilma Vavrusa, who taught English as a second language at the middle school, and Ralph Carter, middle school science teacher. At a previous meeting the board had accepted the resignation of Steve Carroll, Rice High coach.

Teachers hired are Carmen Wiese and Carol J. Dromgoole for Garwood elementary; Sharon Dietz for Eagle Lake primary; Susanne Chis for Rice High English; Jesse Russell, high school coach and history teacher, and Tammi McNeal, who will become physical education teacher and coach at Eagle Lake middle school since Elizabeth Miller, who held that position last year, will be the middle school science teacher this fall. Miller previously taught science at the school.

The test scores show that all objectives in math, reading and writing in grades 3, 5 and 9 have increased, according to the report from Guy Beane who discussed the state testing program formerly known as the TABS test. It now is called TEAM. He went on to say that the increases probably are due to attention given to the TABS objectives, rather than changes in the intellectual ability of students. The school system uses the test results not only to judge the amount of instruction a student has learned, but also to indicate teaching weaknesses so changes can be made in instructional material and procedure.

While students in the above grades were the only ones tested for several years, Beane

said students in grades one through seven will be tested next year. Also, students in grade 11 will be given a grade 12 mastery test, since mastery of both math and language arts is required in order to receive a diploma starting in May, 1987.

Other tests results were discussed by assistant supt. Charles DeShazo. Results show whether students are at the proper learning level. For instance, if a student is half way through the fourth grade, then that student should be at grade level 4.5.

In almost all instances, students in grades four through eight tested above level. Ninth graders, who were administered another exam, tested at grade 9.2 and should have been at least at 9.7.

DeShazo also said the district is expecting increased enrollment next year. About 1,500 students enrolled this past year, and he thinks as many as 1,600 will enroll this fall.

When the board reviewed its reading program, King and DeShazo appeared defensive. Some time ago, the board decided it would make reading the major objective of improvement this coming year, although that information was never released to the public. After the board received a written report on reading, and appeared to be ready to shelve it as is the routine, Reggie Steiner suggested those who teach reading at the elementary level be called together.

He said his reasoning was

that he had heard some teachers complain, and since the board's priority was reading, felt a teacher conference could provide insight. "I thought we wanted more than an administrative review," Briscoe said. Board president Steve Balas agreed. "If we sit here and discuss this tonight, then reading will just be another item on the back burner."

Balas prompted King to appoint a committee of teachers to discuss the system's reading program, and report at the September board meeting.

In other business, the board learned the state requirement for a student-teacher ratio of 25:1 would be met in grades kindergarten through three; that the district will not offer the pre-kindergarten program for disadvantaged pre-schoolers, and that two "portable" classrooms will be built by mid-September at the Eagle Lake primary school at a cost of about \$50,000. Also, the board learned that Rice High School's half-million dollar roof did not leak during the last series of heavy rains. There still is a problem with obtaining a 30-year guarantee, now centered around the drains installed by Dymally Construction of Columbus. Dymally contends it installed the drains properly, and that the specifications did not provide specific details on materials to be used nor method of installation. King said the board's attorney told him he is getting closer to a settlement of the disputed work.

some confusion. The ambulance corps in Sheridan and Eagle Lake both were contacted, but there was some question as to which unit should respond. The sheriff said Flores was taken to Eagle Lake community hospital by the Sheridan ambulance. He was dead on arrival.

Broussard said he called Texas Ranger Nutt to conduct an investigation. Justice M. M. Jones of Eagle Lake ordered an autopsy. The sheriff said his department is not directly involved in the probe; however, he said Nutt was keeping the sheriff and district attorney informed on the progress of the investigation.

Flores was armed with a 410 shotgun, the sheriff said.

Sheriff Broussard said that he and the Texas Ranger have agreed that no statement pertaining to the actual investigation and or evidence will be discussed until the probe is completed and Ranger Nutt has a chance to present his findings to a Colorado County Grand Jury.

"The only comment I have to make at this time," the sheriff wrote, "is I expect all officers to

do everything within their power to prevent a confrontation such as this, however, I expect all officers to defend themselves when the time comes to do so."

Services for Flores were held Saturday, July 6, at Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church in Corpus Christi. Burial was in San Pedro Cemetery in Odem, Texas.

Survivors, in addition to the grandmother and sister at Rock Island, include his wife, Sheila Flores of Corpus Christi, and parents, Mr. and Mrs. Guadalupe Flores Sr., Corpus Christi.

Also surviving are four brothers, Manuel, Miguel, Leroy and Antonio Flores, all of Corpus Christi; paternal grandmother, Camila P. Flores of Corpus Christi; and a maternal great grandmother, Tomasita Longoria of Odem.

Flores reportedly was a member of the Texas National Guard, but reportedly he had been recently transferred from the National Guard to the Army Reserves. A source at the shooting scene said his Army duffel bag with Army supplies and clothing was found there.

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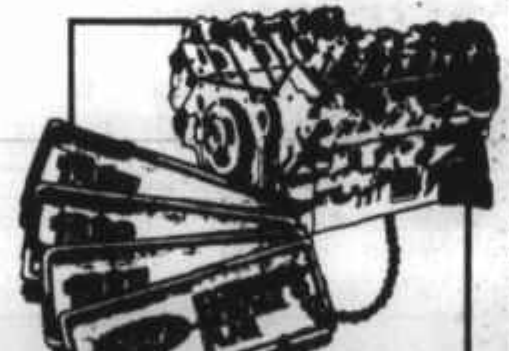
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
