TRAFFIC SIGN COLORS
All highway signs now use specific colors to help direct drivers using the highways and streets. The color red is used only as a background color for stop signs, do-not-enter messages, wrong way signs, passing prohibition signs, and as a legend color for yield signs. Orange is used as a background color for construction and maintenance signs only and is not used for any other purpose. Blue is used as a background color for information signs relating to motorist services including police services and rest areas.

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
