Bolder, darker numbers, such as (7) are the days of the month; lighter numbers and letters, such as (H) are holidays or teacher days, and the consecutively numbered school days.

(H) is a teacher in-service day; Students do not attend. (W) is a teacher workday; Students do not attend. (H) is a school holiday. (B-W/H) is reserved as a bad-weather make-up day; if not needed as make-up, it will be a spring-break holiday.

April 21 is a holiday for teachers and students, but counts as a school day because it was declared by the state; the

Texas Sesquicentennial will be celebrated that day.

The first six weeks ends Oct. 11; second six weeks ends Nov. 22; third six weeks ends Jan. 16; fourth six weeks ends Feb. 28; fifth six weeks ends April 18, and the sixth six weeks ends May 29.

Holidays are Sept. 2, Labor Day; Nov. 28 and 29, Thanksgiving; Dec. 23 through January 3, Christmas and New Year's; March 28-31, Spring Break (may also include March 26 and 27 if bad weather make-up days not needed) and April 21, Texas Sesquicentennial Celebration day.

The teacher in-service day scheduled March 10 is for administration of the new teacher testing program.

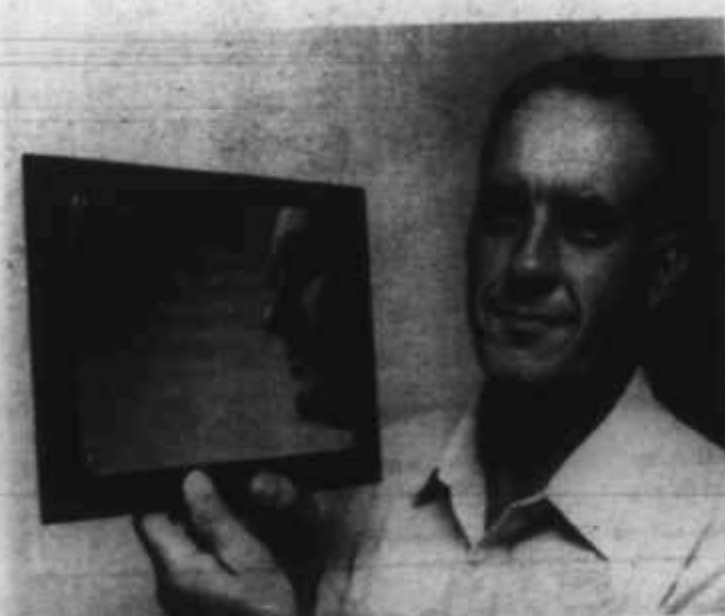
