Toccatas and Flourishes, the team of organist Richard Morris and trumpeter Scott Thornburg will appear on stage Thursday evening, January 23 at 7:30 p.m. at the Wharton High School auditorium.

The concert is the third in the series sponsored by the Wharton County Community Concert Series. It is open to all who hold membership cards.

One of the most popular duos currently performing, Toccatas and Flourishes has toured North America for more than 10 years. Choosing from a repertoire that spans more than four centuries of music, they pair first-rank performances of classical music with their own hard-edged original melodies. The concert explores the almost limitless resources of the "King of Instruments" and the regal sounds of the trumpet, providing "brilliant sound and stunning stage effects."

Richard Morris is one of the very few organists to have appeared in recital at Carnegie Hall, as well as Town Hall and Lincoln Center in New York City. He has also appeared on NBC's Today Show with Toccatas and Flourishes. Trumpeter Scott Thornburg is a sought-after soloist throughout the New York City and surrounding area. He has performed as soloist with many orchestras, including Juilliard Symphony at Lincoln Center.
