One of our recent visitors was Bruce McCarty of Dallas, who very much enjoyed a special tour by Elfe Thomas and Bill Harrison Sr. Bruce grew up in Eagle Lake. His father, the late Bruce W. McCarty, was co-proprietor of The Eagle Lake Headlight and was for many years its very capable editor. Bruce has loaned us a "treasure" in the form of four framed pages of Vol. 1, June 19, 1903, Headlight. I know you will find these pages to be interesting. Bruce's grandfather, Captain James W. McCarty, was the first mayor of Eagle Lake (1888-1889) and also served during the years 1891-1902. He had an uncle, A.M. McCarty, who also was mayor here (1916-1918). The beautiful home in which Bruce grew up is located at the corner of Stockbridge Street and Strickland Avenue. It is now the residence of Mr. and Mrs. W.F. Meizen. McCarty Avenue was named in honor of this family who took so much interest in the development of our city.

There is a beautiful Texas flag in the gift display case. If you would like to be the owner of this wonderful way in which to celebrate Texas' 150th birthday, see one of us on the museum committee. The commemorative books continue to be popular, and we do have a few available at the museum. They are also obtainable at the First National Bank. I'm still hoping that more of you will let us borrow one or more Central items if you are so privileged to own some of these.
