Hajdik, Braden recognized for distinguished services

Leroy J. Hajdik of Columbus, who has served as Colorado County Extension agent for the past nine years, has been named to receive the distinguished service award, the highest recognition given by the National Association of County Agricultural Agents. Dr. William F. "Bill" Braden received the distinguished performance award.

The service award is presented annually to county agents nationwide who have made outstanding contributions to agriculture and improved living.

Hajdik is one of eight county agents with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service to receive the award, which will be presented at the NACAA meeting July 27-31 in Colorado Springs, Colorado. He also will receive special recognition at the TCAAA meeting August 3-6 in Fort Worth.

Hajdik has conducted outstanding result demonstration and educational programs in a broad range of subjects, including corn, sorghum, rice, soybean and livestock production. During his 10-year tenure, the county's agricultural income has increased from \$30 million to \$72 million.

One of Hajdik's most successful endeavors has been an annual rice field day which regularly attracts more than 400 producers. This along with other educational programs on rice production have played a key part in boosting Colorado County from fifth to second in the state in income from rice.

Hajdik also played a key role in the reorganization of the Colorado County Fair a few years ago, and that event has become highly successful and a boon to the county.

The county agent also has given strong leadership to the 4-H program, and this has brought about increased interest among eligible

Through his efforts the 4-H shooting sports program has been especially successful, and members have excelled in district and state trap and skeet competition. During his career, he has coached a number of state and national 4-H award winners. Hajdik is a 24-year veteran with the Extension service, beginning his career in Calhoun County in 1962. Three years later he transferred to Goliad County where he served until assuming his current position in 1977.
