Workshops for the 1986 Colorado County Fair Livestock Show have arrived and are available by contacting the Colorado County Extension Agent's office located at 316 Spring Street in Columbus.

The catalogs contain the rules for the youth and adult divisions of the beef, sheep, poultry and rabbit show.

A new feature at this year's fair is a special beef feeder, broiler, turkey and fryer rabbit sale. Entrants must be a member of a Colorado County 4-H Club or FFA chapter.

Rice producers are invited to attend two rice disease workshops to be held this Friday, June 6. Workshops will be held at 10 a.m. starting from the patio of the Eagle Lake Community Center and at 2 p.m. at Texana Seed Company in Garwood.

Producers will receive training in the area rice fields on identification of rice foliar diseases, their control and field survey techniques.

Assisting the county Extension agent in the workshops will be Dr. Roger Jones, extension service plant disease specialist. The workshops are being sponsored by the Colorado Rice and Soybean Committee in cooperation with the Colorado

In the future, all terms of service will be for three years each on a staggered basis.

Nominating petitions must be returned to the FmHA Austin County Office by Tuesday, June 10, 1986.

players were as follows: Arch Cernal, left forward; W. Malcolm Williamson, right forward; Herwin W. Nussbaum, left guard; Howard Fitzgerald, right guard; Ben Hanley, center; and Verner Matthews, substitute. Each player was suited out uniquely. Some even wore white shoes, while others wore black. From time to time I plan to give other interesting facts gleaned from this annual which is indeed an interesting publication. I am especially interested in the date of this yearbook, for that was the time of my first year in school. We have a framed picture of the first grade of 1916 taught by Miss Lucy Hart, a sister of Mrs. Chumney. You will probably be astounded at the quantity of interesting teaching aids that appear in this picture. I feel that she must have been a wonderful teacher. We have the poem "Legend of the Lake" on top of the large library table, which was once a desk in the office of the late O.J. Wintermann. The poem is under glass.
