Students who submit the top nine entries (three in each grade category) will receive special certificates of recognition signed by the governor. Their winning designs will be displayed in the state capitol rotunda. All entries should clearly convey the concept of efficient, non-wasteful use of water in daily activities. The contest rules allow only one entry per student. Each entry must be done with black ink on plain 8 1/2 x 11 inch white paper and be suitable for reproduction. Each must be the student's own original work and be representative of the student's age and grade. On the back side of the upper left corner of each entry must be the student's name, school district, school name, school address, grade, and teacher name. 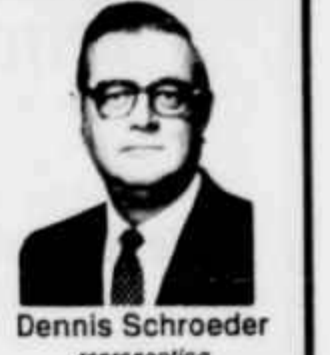
