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Bridges to be painted in county

A pre-construction meeting was held at 2 p.m. on May 22 at the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation office in Victoria to review plans for the painting of nine bridges in District 13.

H&H Materials, Inc. of Kerrville was low bidder for this work at \$179,027, which consists of cleaning and painting of various highway system bridges in DeWitt, Colorado, Lavaca, Jackson, Victoria and Matagorda counties. The contractor has been allotted 60 working days for completion of the work.

R.J. Petrusik Jr., supervising resident engineer in charge of construction, said, "The work at most of these structures involves the cleaning and painting of various types of steel members, while some bridges require only the railing to be cleaned and painted. One travel lane may be closed during painting operations on some of these structures."
