What's a parent's role?

You may have a child that will start school for the first time this fall. We do in our house. I think it might be as exciting for us as it is for our daughter, Amy.

The question here though is what should a parent expect, having no prior contact with a school in the role of a parent?

Looking on the positive side (and ignoring any negative comments that some people are bound to make), the first day of school is as important to the parent as it is to the student.

School is, after all, a joint venture.

The first comment about the parent's role, made in a five-page pamphlet given to parents when their student pre-registered at the Eagle Lake Primary School last spring, is that "the parent's attitude toward the school, teacher, and playmates should be favorable because children sense attitudes and copy them."

The keyword here, to steal an educational phrase, is "sense."

Your first step in helping your child

Schools open soon

Many schools throughout the state will begin classes before the Labor Day weekend this year. In the Rice CISD area, September 1 is the opening day for schools.

Drive carefully and watch out for school children going and coming from schools. *Protect your dreams—drive defensively!*

Here are a few other paragraphs from that school information:

"Make your child feel good about himself. Tell your child when he does something good, when he makes a good decision, or does his work well. Too often we're doing more correction than praising. Stop and see how many times a day you have a negative criticism as compared to a positive praise. When your child comes home with something, talk about it with them. Kindergarten is not a place of grades, so don't over emphasize mistakes. Be ready to listen to your child but don't force him to talk about school. The child's concept about himself plays a major role in his success in school."

"The most important things you can do for your child are talking and reading to him. His vocabulary developed the fastest between the ages of two and four years. A word means nothing to a child if he has not had some experience with it."

"If it is not, he may come to view all school work as a dull and meaningless routine."

As one of my friends said to me this summer, I will be amazed at how fast Amy will learn. With tongue in cheek, he also said it was unfortunate that his son learned so quickly, because school lessons include understanding money.

"That's no new problem in my house though... even my three year old knows how to ask for dollars."
