GUM TAI

Normal, healthy gum is usually pink. As your gum get "sick," irritated by bacterial plaque, it becomes redder, usually starting in the tissue interface between the teeth. Later, it affects the gum in front of the tooth.

The shape of your gum is also important. Is it flat or thickened between the teeth? Are the tips enlarged? Does it emerge from between the teeth? This happens when the gum lining is irritated by bacteria and their products.

Your gum retreats when you're brushing and flossing. It becomes bulky and somewhat forward of the teeth.

Perhaps your gum has receded and you have a dark space between your

teeth that you could enter with a toothpick? What about the gum directly on the front of the tooth? If you can see a darker, yellowish-gray portion of the tooth, you may actually be looking at some of the root that has been exposed by gum recession. Since recession may be caused by bad toothbrushing habits OR by periodontal disease, you had best be examined by your dentist to find out why your root is showing.
