Emergency farm loan applications available

Applications for emergency farm loans for losses caused by drought and excessive heat during the 1990 crop year are being accepted at the Farmers Home Administration (FmHA) office located in Bellville, FmHA County Supervisor Brenda K. Brient said recently.

Austin and Colorado Counties are two of 70 in Texas recently named by Secretary of Agriculture Clayton Yeutter as eligible for loans to cover part of actual production losses resulting from drought and excessive heat.

Ms. Brient said farmers may be eligible for loans of up to 80% of their actual losses or the operating loans needed to continue in business or \$500,000 whichever is less. For farmers unable to obtain credit from private commercial lenders, the interest rate is 0.5%.

"As a general rule, a farmer must have suffered at least a 30% loss of production to be eligible for an FmHA emergency loan," Ms. Brient said. Farmers participating in the PIK or Federal Crop Insurance programs will have to figure in proceeds from those programs in determining their loss.

"Applications for loans under this emergency designation will be accepted until August 26, 1991 but farmers should apply as soon as possible.

Delays in applying could create backlogs in processing, possibly over into the new farming season," Brient said.

FmHA is a credit agency of the U.S. Department of Agriculture. It is authorized to provide disaster emergency loans to recognized farmers who work at and rely on farming for a substantial part of their living. Eligibility is extended to individual farmers who are U.S. citizens and to farm partnerships, corporations or co-operators in which U.S. citizens hold a majority interest.

The FmHA office in Bellville is open from 8 a.m. until noon and 1 to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.
