Myth: Alcohol takes the edge off of being nervous and people can perform better after a couple of drinks.
Fact: Even small amounts of alcohol can disturb your ability to function emotionally and physically. It slows your reaction time, decreases physical coordination and balance, alters your vision and interferes with the capacity to make sound judgements or concentrate fully.

Myth: It will take longer to develop an alcohol problem if you only drink beer than it does if you drink hard liquor.

Fact: The type of alcohol one chooses to consume has nothing to do with the length of time it takes to develop a drinking problem since a person can get just as drunk on beer as he or she gets on another type of alcoholic drink.

Myth: I can't be an alcoholic because I don't drink constantly.

Fact: An alcoholic does not necessarily drink daily, weekly or monthly. What makes someone an alcoholic is the fact that when they drink, they cannot stop after one or two drinks. Instead they lack the ability to control the amount consumed, and in turn get drunk.

Myth: Teenagers are too young to become alcoholics.

Fact: The largest number of alcoholics are young men under 30. Teens can and do become alcoholics. Alcoholism has nothing to do with age. It has to do with developing a tolerance to alcohol so that the body needs increasing amounts of it, leading to addiction. Alcoholism can occur at any age.

The market continued strong in all areas. Stocker and feeder calves were \$2 to \$5 higher on the good quality steers and heifers. We had a lot of good buyers on hand to make a very active sale. Packer cows and bulls sold steadily on approximately 100 head on hand.

The Mouth of the Colorado River water project received \$1 million for construction of a diversion dam and connecting channel for navigation/environmental project which is scheduled for completion in 1993. The last project in the 14th District to receive

Matagorda erosion study which received \$50,000 for its continuation of the feasibility study of Matagorda County. The Matagorda Ship Channel received \$360,000 for continuation of a feasibility study to enlarge the 36-foot ship channel and \$2.668 million for routine maintenance.

The 14th District also received a significant amount of funding for several U.S. Army Corps of Engineers water projects. The Channel to Victoria project was allocated \$176,000 for operation and maintenance and \$442,000 for completion of preconstruction, engineering and design scheduled to begin in fiscal 1993.

The Gulf Intracoastal Waterway at Sargent Beach was allocated \$410,000 for its feasibility study on protection of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway from the erosion of the Texas coastline. The project also has \$450,000 for initiation of preconstruction, engineering and design of Gulf Intracoastal Waterway erosion protection measures, which is tentatively scheduled for the mid
