PROPER METHOD OF PROTESTING TO COLORADO COUNTY APPRAISAL REVIEW BOARD FOR 1991

A taxpayer may protest any action taken by the Appraisal District that affects his or her property's taxable value. A protest should be filed with the Central Appraisal District office prior to July 8, 1991. The 1991 Appraisal Review Board consists of three local taxpayers that are nominated by each school district. The last scheduled day to hear appeals for local property is June 26. Additional days will be added if necessary.

All O&G, utilities, and gravel protests will be heard on July 2 from 10 to 12 noon. It will not be necessary to file a protest prior to that date. Representatives of Capitol Appraisal Group, Inc., of Austin, will be present to discuss values for the above properties. A protest must be filed by the taxpayer or his agent is not satisfied with the explanation given about these values and if they want to appeal to the Appraisal Review Board.

We recommend that taxpayers visit with the Central Appraisal District staff and review their account before protesting. To protest local properties, an appointment should be made with the Central Appraisal District office. The reason for protest, the property description and account number must be given at the time the appointment is made. An official protest form may be filed at the time of hearing.

The protest will be heard by the Appraisal Review Board. It will consist of the taxpayer or authorized agent giving sworn testimony during a 20-minute time slot. The taxpayer gives his evidence and then the Appraisal Staff presents the Central Appraisal District evidence. It is recommended that taxpayers concentrate their appeal on market value and not "high taxes". The ruling by the Appraisal Review Board will be given immediately if possible. Additional time for examination may be necessary in some cases.
