NOTICE OF CHANGES TO ELECTION PRECINCT BOUNDARIES

STATE OF TEXAS §
COUNTY OF COLORADO §

On this 28th day of October, 1991, the Colorado County Commissioners' Court ordered certain changes to the County Election Precincts pursuant to Chapter 42 of the Texas Election Code, such changes to become effective on January 1, 1992. The changes were necessitated in order to conform election precinct boundaries with the County Commissioner precinct boundaries adopted by the County Commissioners' Court on October 28, 1991. As amended, these election precincts and the general areas affected are: Election Precinct No. 1 with boundary changes in the City of Columbus, the Rock Island area, and east of the Colorado River; Election Precinct No. 2 with boundary changes relocated on the southeastern section west of Road 808 and north of Interstate Highway 10; Election Precinct No. 3 with boundary changes extending southerly along State Highway 71 east of Washington Carver area, extending westerly across State Highway 71 to the Tate gas field area and extending northerly; Election Precinct No. 4 east of Highway 71 and south of Garwood, and west to FM 1693; Election Precinct No. 5 east of State Highway 71 and south of Garwood and south of Road 333; Election Precinct No. 6, easternmost boundary at State Highway 71, northerly boundary along Highway 90A to Rock Island and southwesterly to the county line; Election Precinct No. 7 extends to the westerly edge of Rock Island and boundaries north of the above are modified; Election Precinct No. 8 boundaries were modified to begin at the Fayette County line and include minor modifications to all northerly, easterly and southerly boundaries; Election Precinct No. 9 east of Columbus, west and south of Miller's Creek and south of Weimar; Election Precinct No. 16 extending to U.S. 90A east of and bordering the Colorado River; Election Precinct No. 17 from U.S. Highway 90A to intersection of 102 and 949; Election Precinct No. 18 within the City of Columbus. Additional information concerning these changes is available in the Colorado County Judge's office, Colorado County Courthouse.
