SOLID WASTE SITE
Dunham Environmental Services, Inc. has filed Application No. 2168 with the Texas Department of Health for a permit to operate a proposed Type V (medical waste incinerator) municipal solid waste site to be located 6,700 feet west, northwest of the intersection of FM 102 and US 90A, west of Eagle Lake, in Colorado County, Texas. The site consists of approximately 27.33 acres of land, and is to daily receive approximately 25 tons of solid wastes under the regulatory jurisdiction of the Department when disposed of or otherwise processed in accordance with the Department's Municipal Solid Waste Management Regulations.
Pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Solid Waste Disposal Act, Chapter 361, Health and Safety Code, the Department's Municipal Solid Waste Management Regulations, and the Administrative Procedure and Texas Register Act (Art. 6252-13a, V.T.C.S.), a public hearing on the aforesaid application to amend the said permit will be held at: The Eagle Lake Community Center, 100 Walnut Street in Eagle Lake, Texas, at 9:30 a.m. on December 30, 1991, to receive evidence for and against the issuance of a permit for the aforesaid application. The hearing will be conducted and the final decision will be rendered in accordance with the applicable rules as of November 21, 1991, contained in the Department's said regulations. All parties having an interest in this matter shall have the right to appear at the hearing, present evidence and be represented by counsel. Pursuant to Art. 6252-13a, V.T.C.S., and the Department's Formal Hearing Procedures, the cost of a written hearing transcript may be assessed against one or more designated parties.

Regional community development funding evaluations to be made

The Gulf Coast area's Community Development Program Regional Review Committee has set Wednesday, Dec. 4, to evaluate and score 39 applications from small communities seeking 1991 funding from the State for housing, streets, and water and sewer system improvements.

The Regional Review Committee is made up of 12 local elected officials appointed by the Governor to review requests coming from cities and counties in the area served by the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) for funding under the Texas Community Development Program.
The public and representatives of all interested communities are encouraged to attend the Dec. 4 meeting at Houston's Marriott Astrodome Hotel, 2100 Braeswood at Greenbriar. It will begin at 9 a.m.

Texas Community Development grant funds, used principally for public improvements such as housing rehabilitation, water and sewer system improvements, and drainage and street projects, can be crucial to local government efforts to preserve the quality of neighborhoods and to upgrade basic facilities, particularly those which serve low and moderate income persons.

This year 39 agencies have applied for funding under the State grants program, including five counties and 34 cities. Last year only 18 communities applied, but only nine received funding, since limited funds are available under the program.
Those nine successful applicants received \$2,980,106 for use in making public improvements. This year, applying communities will be competing for \$2,338,772 and, again, the competition will be intense since the 39 applicants are asking for a total of \$12,115,908 in funding.

After the Regional Review Committee completes its work, its regional scores will be combined with the State's own scoring of the applications. The results of the combined scores will determine which communities receive grants. Announcement of the grant awards is expected to be made by Governor Ann Richards in early 1992.

Oral presentations from applicants or their representatives will be limited to a total of 10 minutes at the Dec. 4 meeting. The schedule for presentations, based on an at-random drawing, is available by telephoning H-GAC's Carl Masterson in Houston at 713-627-3200.

The Regional Review Committee, appointed by the Governor, is chaired by Commissioner Wayne Johnson of Galveston County. Others serving include Commissioner Catherine Drapela, Wharton County; Commissioner Johnnie Elstner, Colorado County and County Judge Dempsey Henley, Liberty County.
Others are Commissioner Melvin Hunt of Liberty County, Mayor Herbert L. Johnson of Hempstead, Councilman Vernon Kemp of Mont Belvieu, Mayor Tommy LeTulle of Bay City, County Judge Oscar F. Nelson, Jr. of Chambers County, Mayor Scott Parker of Liberty, Commissioner Grady Prestage of Fort Bend County and Mayor A.R. Rusty Senac of Beach City.
