Scheduled to play in the tournament at eighth grade level are Columbus, La Grange and Needville; at seventh grade level are Columbus, St. Phillips and Needville.

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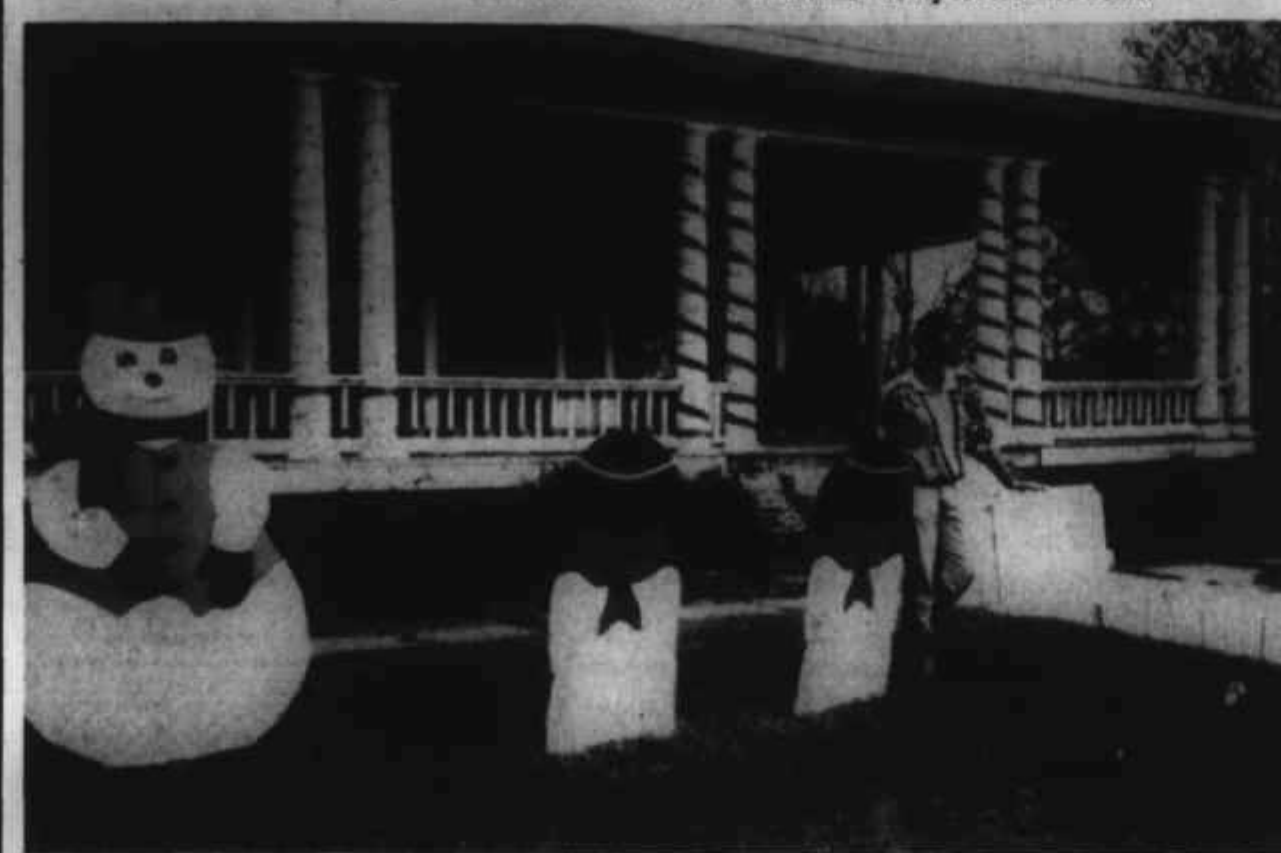
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Christmas theme 'Yard' awarded to Scotts

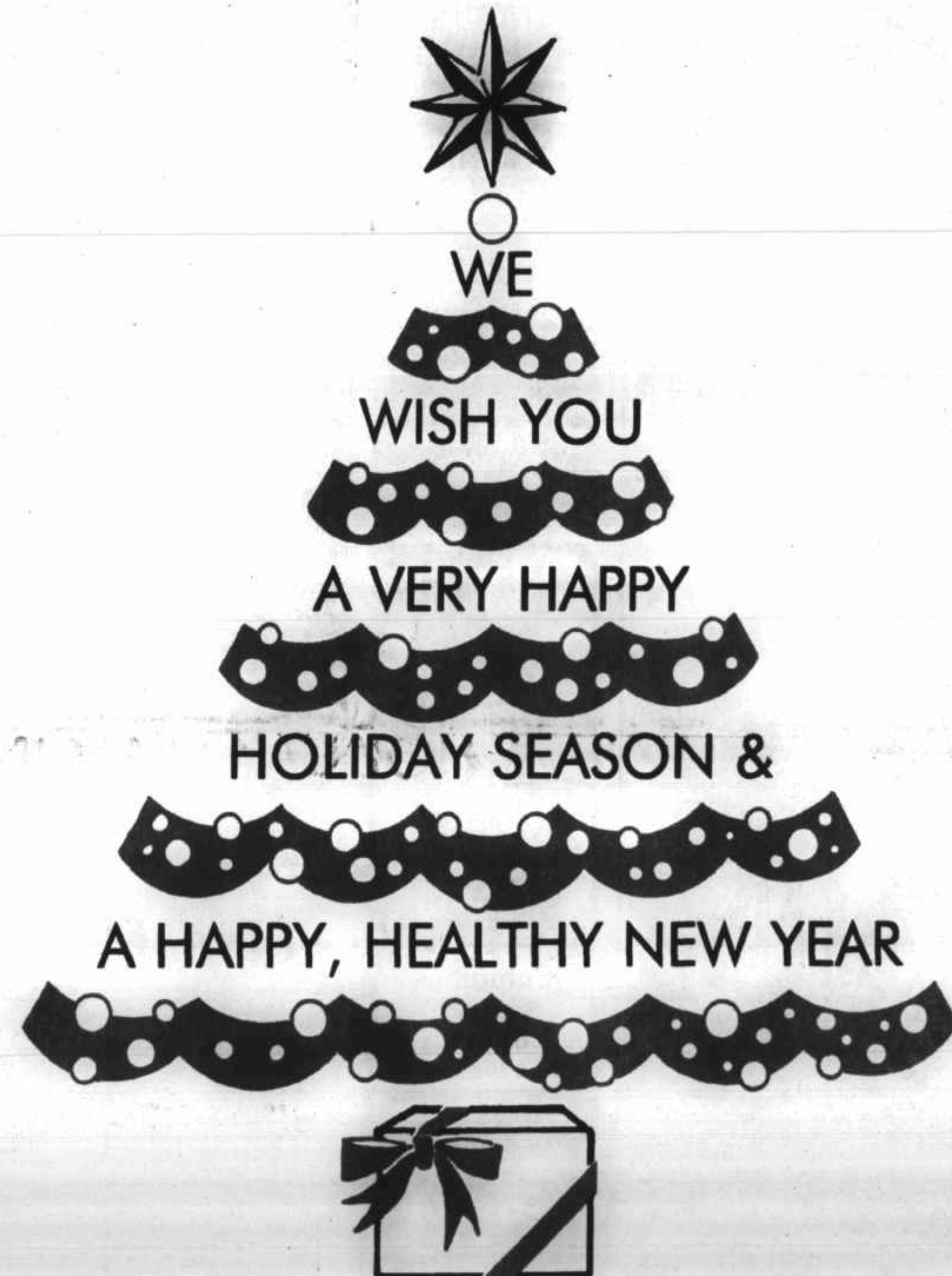
