Field office restructure aim is efficiency

A sweeping restructuring and streamlining of Texas Department of Agriculture field offices took effect recently. The action is aimed at making the agency more service oriented.

Under the changes, TDA is consolidating its statewide network of offices to create five regional centers and seven satellite offices. Regional operations will be based in Lubbock, San Juan, Dallas, Houston and San Antonio.

Under their restructuring, TDA offices in Amarillo and El Paso, once district offices, will become satellite offices of the regional center in Lubbock.

Governor announces juvenile justice grants
