Pasture program scheduled Monday

The Colorado County Extension Livestock Committee has scheduled a pasture program for March 2 in Weimar. The program will begin at 5:30 p.m. at one of Franklin Addick's winter pastures near Weimar. To get to this pasture, take County Road 240 south from Weimar and turn right onto County Road 243. The pasture is located on the left on this road.

Participants on the tour will view the County Winter Small Grain Varietal Test. The test has 15 varieties of oats, ryegrass, triticale, wheat and rye. Following the tour, the group will return to the St. Michael Family Center on Highway 155 north in Weimar. They will be served a meal and refreshments compliments of area agribusiness.

Dr. Neal Pratt, Extension Forage Specialist, will lead the program with a discussion about pasture management. Carl Rost, Texas Department of Agriculture, will give an update on TDA laws and regulations. Representatives from the Texas Animal Health Commission will discuss the accelerated brucellosis testing program in Colorado County.

Private applicators licensed by the TDA may obtain two continuing education credits for recertification by attending this program.
